Accessibility Information – John Cumming Stadium

1. Introduction

The John Cumming Stadium, Carluke, is the home of Carluke Rovers football club. The attached information provides accessibility details for the stadium during Rover's home games.

The stadium can be found on the east side of Carluke, on Carnwath Road, adjacent to Carluke High School.

2. Finding us

2.1 From the M8.

Eastbound – Exit at Junction 7

At the roundabout take the 1st exit onto A8

At the roundabout take the 2nd exit and stay on A8

After 900m stay left to stay on A8

At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto A73 towards Newhouse Roundabout

Westbound – Exit at Junction 6. Take the first exit onto the A73 towards Newhouse Roundabout

At the Newhouse roundabout, take the 2nd exit, stay on A73 (Carlisle Road).

At Bellside roundabout take the 2nd exit, stay on A73.

At Newmains roundabout take the 3rd exit and stay on A73.

At the Bogside Roundabout take the 2nd exit, stay on A73 to Carluke.

In Carluke, at Castlehill Roundabout take the first exit and stay on A73/ Stewart Street. Continue on Stewart St until the traffic lights at Glamis Avenue. Turn left onto Glamis Avenue/A72.

At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Chapel Street/A721.

At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Carnwath Road/A721.

After 650 metres, turn left into the grounds of Carluke Leisure Centre.
After 60 metres turn right into the car park of Carluke High School.
Continue forward to the gates at the entrance to the John Cumming Stadium.

2.2 From M74

Southbound

Exit at Junction 7. At the end of the slip road turn left onto A72 (Lanark Road).
At the roundabout take the 1st exit onto Cornsilloch Brae/ A71. .

Northbound –

Exit at Junction 8. At the Canderside Toll roundabout take the 4th exit onto A71.
At the roundabout take the 2nd exit to stay on A71/Cornsilloch Brae towards Garrion Bridge.

At Garrion Bridge roundabout take the 1st exit onto Horsley Brae.
At the traffic lights take the left side filter and turn onto Brownlee Road.
After 500m turn right onto Mauldslie Road.
After 2.3 miles. At the roundabout take the 2nd exit and stay on Mauldslie Road.
In Carluke, at the roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Clyde Street.
After 800m, at the traffic lights turn left onto Stewart St / A73.
At the traffic lights turn left onto Glamis Avenue.
At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Chapel Street/A721.
At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Carnwath Road/A721.
After 650 metres, turn left into the grounds of Carluke Leisure Centre.
After 60 metres turn right into the car park of Carluke High School and the main car park for the stadium
Continue forward to the gates at the entrance to the John Cumming Stadium.

2.3 Access to the stadium

Access to the stadium is via the gate at the bottom of the driveway.



The main gate is kept locked on match days to prevent unauthorised access to a car parking area, which has 4 accessible car park spaces at the top of the drive. These are for blue badge holders only.

There is a pedestrian access gate at the main gate which is kept open on match days.

To access the accessible car park spaces contact must be made with reception desk at the stadium to arrange for the attendant to unlock the gate.

As the stadium is owned by South Lanarkshire Council, and is not always open, enquiries outwith matchdays should be to the adjacent Carlisle Leisure Centre on **015555 751384**.

2.4 Parking at the stadium

There are 4 disabled parking bays adjacent to the stadium, at the top of the driveway. Access to these bays is via the driveway from the main gate.



2.5 Accessible entrance to stadium

Access to the stadium is via the ticket gate at the end of the main building. If necessary, the larger side gate could be opened to allow access.



2.6 Ticket prices

Payment at the gate at the Carlisle Rovers matches can be with cash and card.

Ticket prices for season 2025 - 2026 are:

Adults £6

Concessions £3

Supporters who are disabled are charged at the Concessionary rate. Personal assistant with a supporter who is disabled are free of charge.

2.7 Facilities at the stadium

There is an accessible viewing shelter which is put in place on match days. It can accommodate up to 2 wheelchair users and personal assistants.

Elsewhere in the stadium there is a covered stand for supporters. However, as this is a stepped standing area with barriers, it is not accessible for wheelchair users.

There are toilet facilities for supporters, who are disabled, in the main building immediately adjacent to the ticket gate.



The accessible toilet is on the right of the three toilets. Currently it has a key lock and should be open on match days. The stadium owners are in the process of arranging to have a radar lock fitted.

There is a small refreshment kiosk run by the club. It is further along the main building from the toilets.

The service is through a window on the side of the building. It is not accessible for a spectator in a wheelchair.

However, adjacent to the kiosk window is an indoor space used for providing hospitality to provide committee members from the visiting committee with light refreshments at half time.

This area is accessible and can be used by wheelchair users.

Also, a food delivery service can be provided if required. Please speak to the individual at the gate if you require this service.

There is a spectator barrier restricting access to the playing surface. There is a path on the outside of the spectator fence, which continues around the entire pitch.
